The National Energy Board (the Board or NEB) hereby advises the Minister of Environment that the above-noted Project, if approved and undertaken, may affect Polar Bear listed on Schedule 1 of the SARA.

On 16 April 2010, TGS/PGS/MKI applied to the NEB to conduct a two dimensional marine seismic program in the Baffin Bay and Davis Strait area. Please note the NEB previously notified Environment Canada about this proposed Project in its Federal Coordination letter dated 26 January 2011, and has received letters of comment from Environment Canada on 30 March 2012 and 28 May 2011.
